PAWIKAN HAT MAKING COMPETITION

November 29, 2025

Theme: Pag-aalaga sa Pawikan, Tagumpay ng Kalikasan!

Contest Guidelines:

1. Participants will create unique and creative hats inspired by pawikan (sea turtles) to raise awareness about marine conservation and the importance of protecting these remarkable creatures.
2. The contest is open to all senior high school student. There shall be only one (1) design and one student designer per school.
3. Participants may use a variety of materials to create their hats, including but not limited to: paper, fabric, cardboard, paint, recyclable materials. All materials must be safe and non-toxic.
4. Participating student designers should be duly endorsed by their respective school principals. The endorsement shall contain the following information:
 - Full name and current grade of student designer
 - Concept for the hat design. This shall be a brief description for the idea for the hat design, which includes, but are not limited to: (1) materials to be used, (2) prominent colors to be used, and (3) other design eliminates and iconography to be featured.

The endorsement shall be submitted on or before November 14, 2025. Incomplete endorsements shall not be counted as official entries. The endorsement shall be submitted to tourism@bataan.gov.ph with the subject Pawikan Hat Making Competition 2025. Endorsements submitted after the deadline, or incomplete endorsement after the deadline shall not be considered.

5. The pawikan hat should be worn by the participating school during the Walk for a Cause on November 29, 2025 5:00 AM. Each school should have a minimum of 5 persons wearing the pawikan hat, including the student designer. The worn pawikan hat should have the same design.
6. Judging will be on November 29, 2025 during the Walk for a Cause.

Criteria for Judging

- **Creativity and Originality** - - - - - 40%
Innovative design and unique interpretation of the theme
- **Craftsmanship** - - - - - 40%
Quality of materials and construction
- **Theme representation** - - - - - 20%
How well the hat represents the theme

2025 DIVISION PAWIKAN QUIZ BEE

GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS

- Participants should be bona fide students of the representing district/school, with the following school levels:
 - For elementary school category:** Each district will send (1) contestant from Grade 6 from public and private schools. 17 students will be endorsed by SDO Bataan and 11 students will be endorsed by SDO City of Balanga.
 - For junior high school category:** One (1) contestant per school from Grade 9 both from private and public high schools. 33 students will be endorsed by SDO Bataan and 10 students will be endorsed by SDO City of Balanga.
 - For senior high school category:** One (1) contestant from either Grade 11 or Grade 12, both from private and public high schools. 33 students will be endorsed by SDO Bataan and 10 students will be endorsed by SDO City of Balanga.
- The in-person quiz bee will be held on November 24, 2025 (Monday) from 8:30 AM to 11:30 AM for the Elementary Level, and from 1:00 PM to 4:30 PM for Junior High School and on November 25, 2025 from 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM for Senior High School. The venue for this activity will be at the Bataan Tourism Pavilion, City of Balanga, Bataan.
- There will be easy, average, and difficult rounds. The scoring is as follows:

Easy: one (1) point
Average: two (2) points
Difficult: three (3) points
- The ten (10) test questions per category of the Pawikan Quiz Bee will come from the following areas:

Part I: Ecosystem
Part II: Marine Life
Part III: Pawikan
- The contestant with the highest number of correct answers will be declared the champion, the second highest will take second place, and the third highest will take third place. In case of a tie, a tie-breaker question will be provided during the clincher round.
- In case of a protest, only the official participants are allowed to raise their inquiries as early as possible during the contest, addressed to the chairperson of the Board of Judges.
- The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable.
- Submission of endorsement as the official representative of DepEd Province or DepEd City shall be emailed to tourism@bataan.gov.ph on or before November 14, 2025
- Certificates of Recognition and prizes will be awarded as follows:

First Place:	Php 5,000.00
Second Place:	Php 3,000.00
Third Place:	Php 2,000.00
Consolation Prize:	Php 1,000.00

Certificates of Participation will be given to all students and teacher-coaches.
