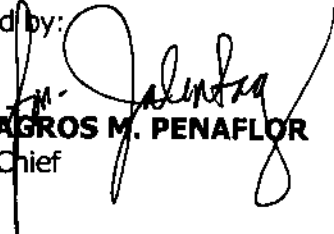

Dear **Dr. Violeta**:

Greetings of Good Health!

The highlight provisions of the Universal Health Care (UHC) Law endeavors to: (1) enroll all Filipinos in the National Health Insurance Program, and (2) ensure equitable access to quality and affordable healthcare services and protecting them from financial risks. Further, the "UHC whole-of-government" approach refers to the comprehensive strategy mandated by the Philippine Universal Health Care Act (Republic Act No. 11223) where all government agencies, not just the Department of Health (DOH), are responsible for coordinating efforts to achieve UHC for all Filipinos.

The Department of Education (DepEd) and the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on May 8, 2025, to ensure health coverage for all learners by registering them with PhilHealth, making school clinics primary care access points, and facilitating family registration for PhilHealth's YAKAP (formerly Konsulta) Package. An enhanced version of the PhilHealth Learners Manual (PLM) jointly developed by the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PHIC) and the Department of Education (DepEd) is currently available as primary material in integrating the National Health Insurance Program (NHIP) as a lesson/module in teaching MAPEH (Music, Arts, Physical Education, and Health) to Grade 8 students.

Relative to this, we seek to start off the implementation at the local level with the introduction of the PLM to the **thirty-nine (39) Grade 8 MAPEH teachers** under your jurisdiction through the conduct of Training of Trainers (TOT) on **November 24, 2025** from 9:00am to 4:00pm at Crown Royale Hotel, City of Balanga, Bataan.

The primary objective is to (1) **Enhance** the knowledge level of Grade 8 MAPEH Teachers on the National Health Insurance Program; (2) **Equip** Grade 8 MAPEH Teachers with materials in teaching the National Health Insurance Program as a lesson/module in MAPEH; and (3) **Integrate** the social health insurance module in the secondary education curriculum starting off with Grade 8 students.

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Also, the activity has a secondary objective namely: (1) **Instill** the value of having social health insurance coverage to the Grade 8 student learners, and (2) **Empower** the Grade 8 Teachers and Learners as agents and advocates of positive change in promoting health insurance coverage, enrolment to the National Health Insurance Program of the academic community (households of the faculty, learners, alumni, and all others) and availment of the benefits and services as provided for under the Universal Health Care Law.
