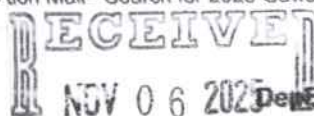
This Office informs all concerned that the Commission on Human Rights Region III announces the Call for Nominations for the 2025 Gawad Karapatang Pantao (GKP).

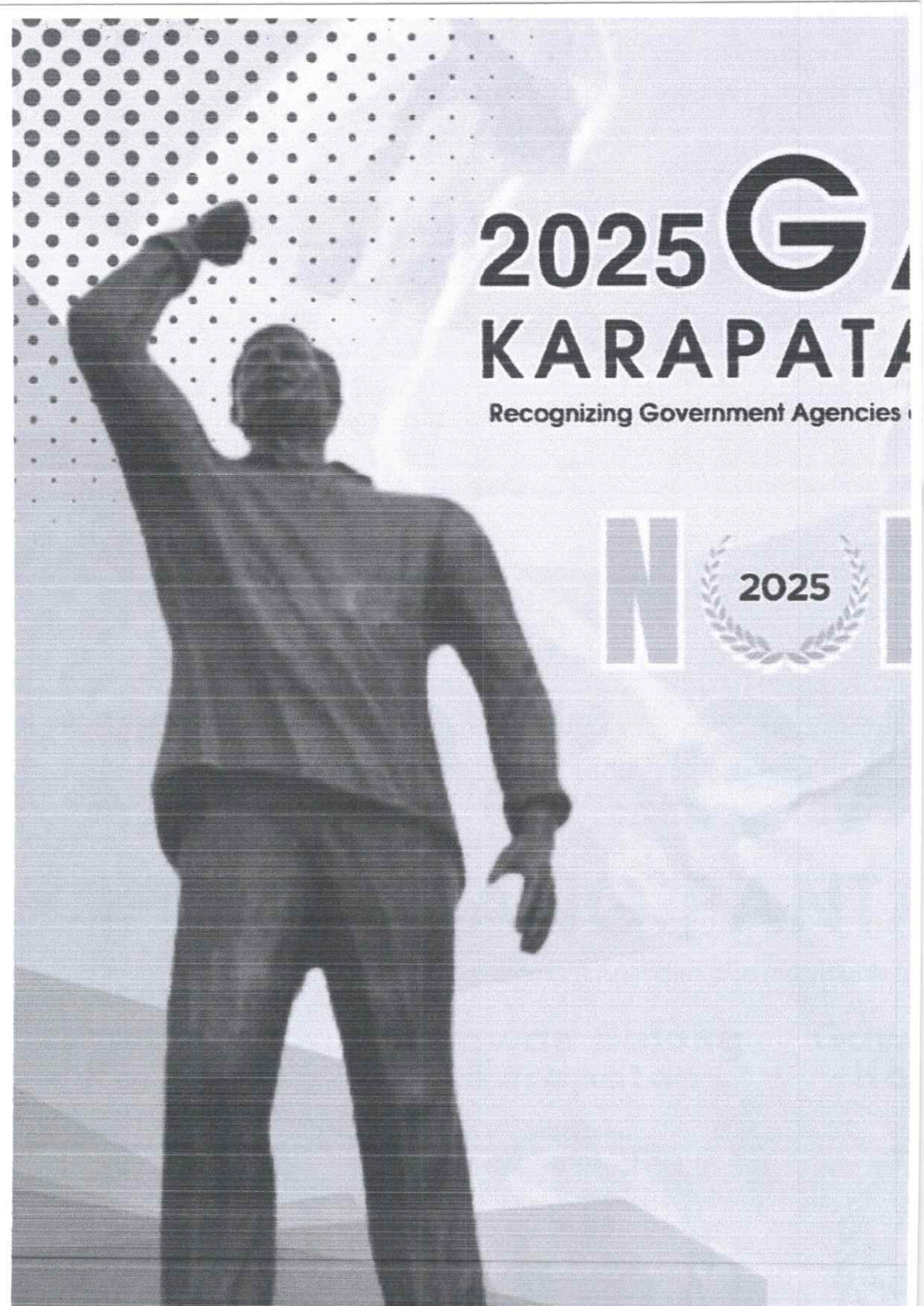

SCOPE OF THE AWARD

The **Gawad Karapatang Pambansa** recognizes and rewards outstanding programs and initiatives of government employees/private organizations that aim to further the cause of human rights in the past 3 years from the time of nomination. Programs and initiatives must be accomplished over and beyond the call of duty. It shall cover all employees, regardless of appointive officials and employees of permanent, temporary, coterminous, and casual status of the government.

CATEGORIES OF THE A

1. **Gawad Bantay Karapatan** is conferred upon individuals working within a government who have exceptionally contributed to the prevention of human detention.
2. **Gawad Gabay Karapatan** is conferred upon individuals working within a government who have exceptionally contributed to the furtherance of human rights (e.g. research, situation monitoring reports, etc.).
3. **Gawad Sulong Karapatan** is conferred upon individuals working within a government who have exceptionally contributed to the promotion of human rights through awareness-raising, education and training, etc.
4. **Gawad Tanggol Karapatan** is conferred upon individuals working within a government who have exceptionally contributed to the protection of human rights through investigation, prosecution, provision of legal aid, etc.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Nominees must meet the following qualifications:

1. Have rendered at least **three (3) years** of **government service** as of date of submission. Significant accomplishment which the nominee is being recognized made within the **last three (3) years** of nomination, and have been consistently carried out by the nominee during service.
2. Have not been found guilty of any offense involving moral turpitude and
3. Nominated government offices/department must present proof of projects initiated and impact/evaluation of projects initiated.

NOMINATION FOLDER

Each nomination folder/portfolio must contain:

- **Accomplished Nomination Form** – it details the description of his/her/their initiative. This form is available on the CHR website or any of its social media platforms (on Nomination Form);
- **Certification of No-Pending Administrative Cases**
- **Supporting materials** – pictures/articles or 3 other supporting materials that depict initiatives of the nominee, documenting the project initiated and impact.

The nomination form and other documents should be placed in the folder.

Note: Hard-bound and creative covers are encouraged. Reports, recommendations from institutions/partners, training, seminars, and recognition should not be placed in the folder.

For nominees who accept, the Regional 2 – Accomplishment Form and require supporting portfolio and relevant documents of nominee's qualifications and contribution.

5. Regional Screening and Validation

The Regional Screening Committee validate all submitted nomination folder and authenticity. Additional supporting documents requested, if necessary. The RSC deliberations to determine the Gawad Regional Awardee for each award. Regional Awardee per category may be Screening Committee (NSC).
