

# CONCEPT NOTE PASS-A-BOOK PROJECT

### Background and Rationale

The National Children's Month (NCM) is celebrated every November pursuant to Republic Act No. 10661, which declares the month as a special period to recognize, uphold, and advance the rights of Filipino children. This annual observance also reaffirms the Philippines' commitment as a State Party to the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) — ensuring that every child enjoys their rights to survival, development, protection, and participation.

In support of the 2025 NCM theme, "OSAEC-CSAEM Wakasan: Kaligtasan at Karapatan ng Bata, Ipaglaban!", the Regional Sub-Committee for the Welfare of Children (RSCWC) III, in partnership with the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) Field Office III, will implement the annual Pass-A-Book Project. This initiative promotes a culture of reading, learning, and sharing, while reinforcing the collective commitment to uphold every child's right to education and development.

### II. Objectives

The Pass-A-Book Project aims to:

1. Promote the joy of learning and foster literacy among children in Central Luzon;

 Encourage individuals, government agencies, local government units, civil society organizations (CSOs) to share the gift of knowledge through book and material donations;
