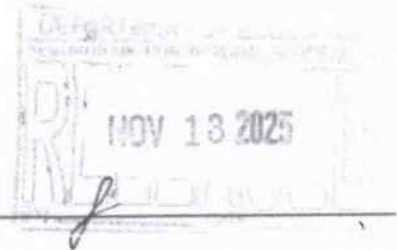

**REGIONAL ENGAGEMENT ACTIVITY ON MARITIME AWARENESS AND
WEST PHILIPPINE SEA EDUCATION**

To : Schools Division Superintendents
Public Schools District Supervisors
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All Others Concerned

1. The West Philippine Sea is of critical national importance in terms of maritime security, resource management, environmental protection, and the welfare of coastal communities. At the same time, basic education institutions have a role in fostering maritime awareness and civic consciousness among learners. In recognition of this, the Department of Education Region III (DepEd-Region III) and the Philippine Coast Guard - West Philippine Sea Transparency Group (PCG-WPSTG), shall undertake a joint engagement activity on **November 8, 2025**, at **Robinsons Starmills Pampanga, City of San Fernando (P)**.
2. The main objective of the activity is to promote maritime awareness and strengthen public understanding of West Philippine Sea (WPS) issues.
3. Teachers attending the said activity shall be granted service credits while Compensatory Time Off (CTO) for the non-teaching personnel of November 8, 2025 (Saturday) pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2023 (Guidelines on the grant of vacation service credits for teachers) and CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s.2004 (Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Services).
4. The PCG-WPSTG will provide meals (lunch and P.M. snacks) STG. At the same time, transportation expenses of all participants shall be charged to local funds, subject to the government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

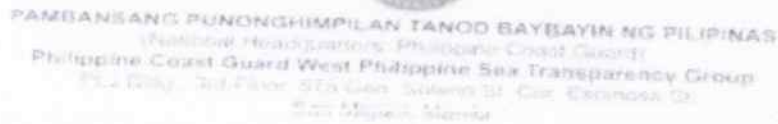
