**IMPLEMENTATION AND REGISTRATION FOR THE  
PHILHEALTH YAKAP PACKAGE UNDER DEPED SDO BATAAN**

1. The "Konsultasyong Sulit at Tama" or PhilHealth Yakap Package is an outpatient health service covered by PhilHealth. It is an expansion of the primary care benefit mandated by the Universal Health Care Law to provide coverage for all Filipinos.
2. Attached herewith are the benefits included in this package *(see Annex A)*.
3. Please refer to **Annex B** for the list of no-cost diagnostic examinations included under the DepEd Bataan Yakap Provider's case management.
4. The following free medicines are provided as part of the DepEd-Bataan Yakap Provider's case administration. *(Refer to the attached file, titled Gamot Coverage)*
5. The additional benefits of enrolling under the DepEd-Bataan PhilHealth Yakap Provider are detailed in **Annex C**.
6. In view of this, all teaching and non-teaching personnel of the SDO Bataan who are not yet registered are expected to complete their registration through the provided link, ensuring that SDO Bataan is selected as their service provider.

7. Personnel currently registered under other YAKAP Providers may transfer or register with the DepEd SDO Bataan YAKAP Provider by accomplishing the PhilHealth Konsulta Registration Form (PKRF) and submitting a photocopy of their valid ID bearing three (3) specimen signatures.

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**Annex A – Benefits of YAKAP**

1. Free health risk screening and assessment.
2. Free initial and follow-up consultations throughout the year with free laboratory.
3. Access to free Diagnostic examination as needed as part of case.
4. Management by DepEd-Bataan Ekonsulta Provider.
5. Access to free medicine as needed as part of case management by DepEd Bataan Ekonsulta Provider.

**Annex B – No cost diagnostic examination**

- Complete Blood Count (CBC) with platelet count
- Lipid Profile (Total Cholesterol, HDL AND LDL Cholesterol Triglycerides)
- Fasting Blood Sugar (FBS)
- Oral Glucose Tolerance Test (OGTT)
- Glycosylated Hemoglobin (HbA1c)
- Creatinine
- Chest X-Ray
- Sputum Microscopy
- Electrocardiogram (ECG)
- Urinalysis
- Pap smear
- Fecalysis
- Fecalt Occult Blood Test



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**Annex C – Additional Benefits**

1. Access to referrals for major hospitals, for cancer screening including:
  - Mammogram
  - Breast Ultrasound
  - Low-dose chest CT scan
  - Alpha fetoprotein
  - Live ultrasound
  - Colonoscopy
2. Free laboratory tests during annual physical check-ups, as allowed by Philhealth.
3. Free financial assistance for catastrophic cases (e.g., cancer, dialysis, and other specialized laboratory services or assistance as recommended by a medical officer and approved by SDO Management)
