  - b. **Promote Quality Leadership Development and Capacity Building Among Learners:** develop competent, values-driven, and future-ready student leaders through leadership formation activities such as the 2026 SSLG Excellence in Leadership Awards and other initiatives that recognize and strengthen learners' leadership competencies. (SDG 4: Quality Education)
  - c. **Recognize and Empower Educators and Student Organizations in Advancing Sustainable Youth Programs:** acknowledge and motivate outstanding student organizations, advisers, and school heads through programs such as the 2026 Gawad Pag-Gabay and 2026 Gawad Tanglaw Awards, thereby fostering collaboration, sustained advocacies, and impactful school-community partnerships. (SDG 11: Sustainable Cities and Communities and SDG 17: Partnerships for the Goals)
