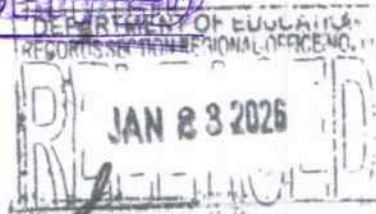
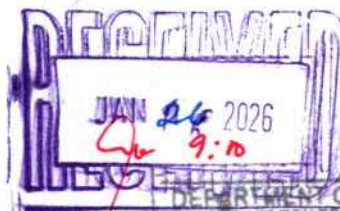

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CONDUCT OF 2026 PSSPA III CONVENTION

1. This is to announce the conduct of the Annual PSSPA III Convention with the theme: **"Resilient, Ethical and Transformational Leadership for Sustainable Impact."** The convention will be held on **February 18, 19, and 20, 2026**, at Grand Regal Hotel, Km 7 JP Laurel Avenue, Lanang, Davao City.
2. This convention aims to address crucial areas that shape effective and resilient school leadership, empowering school heads to navigate their roles in improving school performance and overall well-being. The key objectives include:
  - a. Strengthen transformational and instructional leadership competencies;
  - b. Promote mental health and well-being among school leaders, teachers, and learners;
  - c. Foster inclusive, learner-centered, and future-ready schools; and
  - d. Build strong partnerships with stakeholders for sustainable school improvement.
3. The target participants are the Regional and Division PSSPA III Officers and members, non-members including School Heads, SHS School Assistant Principals, Department Heads, OICS, TICS and those interested school heads of private schools.
4. A registration fee of **Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (P7,800.00)** shall be charged from each participant to cover meals, hotel accommodation, conference kits, venue, honorarium of speakers. The registration fee, travel expenses and other related incidental expenses shall be charge to MOOE or any local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. 5. Registration is strictly **Online**. All participants are required to complete their registration through the official online registration portal provided by the PSSPA III Inc. organizing committee. To ensure smooth logistics and proper documentation, the committee will **not** accommodate walk-in or on the spot registrants during the event. Only those who have successfully registered online will be allowed to
