

6. Members of the Technical Working Group (TWG) such as school heads, head teachers and master teachers are considered participants and are required to pay the registration fee. They are authorized to travel two days prior to the start of the activity for the necessary preparations.

7. Arrival and registration of participants shall be in the morning of Day 1. The first meal to be served shall be AM snack on Day 1, while the last meal to be served shall be lunch on the last day of assembly.
