In reference to the Advisory issued by the **Bureau of Learner Support Services (BLSS)** dated **January 21, 2026**, this Office hereby informs all public and private elementary and secondary schools in the Division regarding the opening of the **National Uploading and Validation of the WASH in Schools (WinS) Program for School Year 2025–2026**.

The uploading shall commence on **January 26, 2026** and will continue until **March 31, 2026**, in accordance with **DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2016** and the **Policy Guidelines for the Comprehensive Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene in Schools (WinS) Program**.

The WinS Program adopts the **Three-Star Approach (TSA)** as an integrated system for monitoring, performance recognition, and quality assurance, guided by **DepEd Memorandum No. 194, s. 2018**.

All concerned are advised of the following:

1. Ensure that the downloaded monitoring forms are the **latest version**, which includes the **SBFP indicator** requesting the number of beneficiaries disaggregated by sex.
2. In case of discrepancy between the results of the **offline monitoring form** and the **uploaded report in the e-OMS**, the result reflected in the **uploaded report in the e-OMS** shall be considered official. The **star rating indicated in the uploaded form shall prevail**.
3. For **non-DepEd elementary and secondary schools**, only a **blank form** shall be uploaded.



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4. In the event of **uploading interruptions**, the issue shall be coordinated directly with **ICTS-SID**. If system maintenance is required, the **Regional WinS Coordinators** will be notified accordingly.

To ensure proper guidance and compliance, all **School Heads, WinS Coordinators, and concerned personnel** are highly encouraged to review the abovementioned issuances.



The Three-Star Approach (TSA) is used by the WinS Program as an integrated system for monitoring, performance recognition and quality assurance guided by DepEd Memorandum No. 194, s. 2018.

Please be advised of the following:

1. Ensure that the downloaded monitoring forms are the latest version which includes the SBFP indicator requesting the number of beneficiaries disaggregated by sex.
2. In the event of a discrepancy between the result of the offline monitoring form and the uploaded monitoring at the e-OMS, the result on the uploaded report in the e-OMS shall be the official star rating. The star rating indicated on the uploaded form shall prevail.
3. For non-DepEd elementary and secondary schools, please upload a blank form only.
4. In the event of an uploading interruption, the issue will be coordinated directly with ICTS-SID. In case the ICTS-SID advises that system maintenance is required, Regional WinS Coordinators will be notified accordingly.
