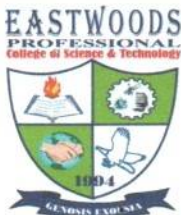

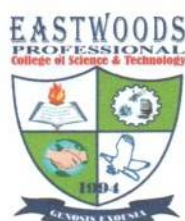

- Recipes must be original.
- Strict food safety, sanitation, and kitchen etiquette must always be observed.

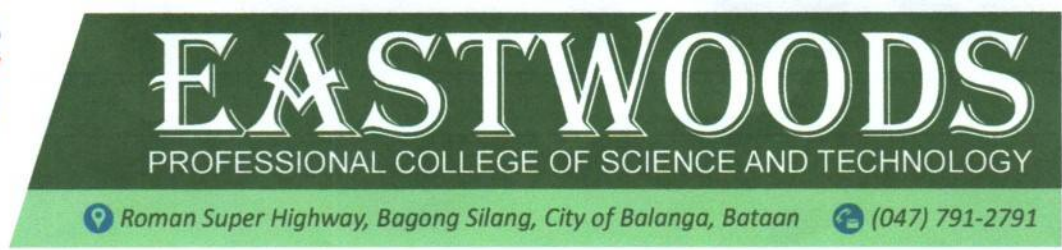
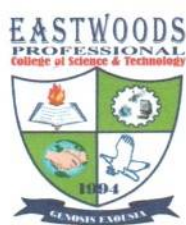
**Competition:** Speed, Skill, and Service: Waiters' Relay Competition

**Time:** 9:00 am- 12:00 pm

#### Mechanics:

- Each team shall consist of four (5) members per school.
- Teams will line up at the starting point.
- At the signal, the first participant will carry a tray with water-filled glasses from the starting point to the designated table set-up area.
- The participant must walk only; running is strictly prohibited.
- Upon reaching the table, the participant shall properly place the glasses on the table following the instructed table set-up.
- After completing the task, the participant will return to the starting point and tag the next teammate.
- Each participant must complete the same task until all team members have finished.
- Spilling of water will result in a corresponding time or point deduction.
- Improper table set-up (wrong placement, missing items, or disorder) will incur penalties.
- Only plastic glasses and safe materials shall be used.
- Teams must follow all safety rules and instructions from officials.
- The team with the fastest completion time and highest total score wins.

- No resizing, cutting, or stacking of the cake
- No additional tools, icing, or materials are allowed
- Sharing of decorations or materials is prohibited

Cake Specification

- **Cake Size: 6 inches in diameter**
- **Type:** Round Sponge Cake (provided by the organizer)
- Cake must not be trimmed, resized, or altered in diameter

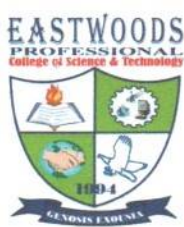
Time Allotment

- **Total Time: 1 hour (60 minutes)**
  - 5 minutes – Preparation & setup
  - 50 minutes – Cake decorating proper
  - 5 minutes – Final touch-ups & area cleanup

<b>Participants:</b>	1 student (Grade 6) 1 coach/instructor 1 student (Grade 10) 1 coach/instructor
<b>Time:</b>	8 am to 10 am (Grade 6 participants) 2:30 pm to 4:30 pm (Grade 10 participants)

**Detailed mechanics:**

1. The contest is open for all Grade 6 and Grade 10 students
2. During the contest proper, the following materials will be used:
  - Buzzer (provided by the facilitator)
  - Writing materials (ballpen and paper)
3. The questions will be from Science and Mathematics subjects
4. The contest will have 3 rounds: Easy, Average, and Difficult round. There will be ten (10) questions for the EASY, five (5) questions for the AVERAGE, and five (5) questions for the DIFFICULT round.
5. The quizmaster shall read each question twice. After the second reading, the quizmaster shall say the word "GO". Only then shall the contestants begin writing their answers on the boards provided. The time allotment is 10 seconds for regular questions and 20 seconds for math questions.
6. After the time limit and buzzer sound, the contestant will automatically stop writing. The contestants should raise their answer, and the correct answer will be flashed on the screen.
7. Any protest or appeals regarding the preceding question will be entertained before the quizmaster proceeds to the next question.

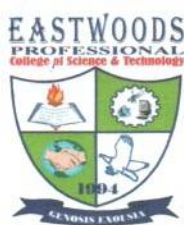

### 3. Spelling Bee: Classic Round

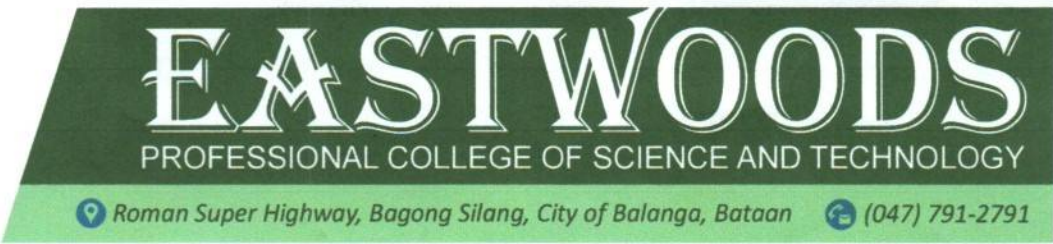
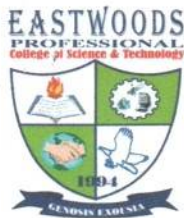
- Traditional spelling bee format
