This relational aspect not only helps students acquire technical skills but also allows them to build confidence and a professional identity, both of which are critical for being prepared for the workforce.

A kind of altruistic duty that goes beyond academic teaching is also embodied by vocational teachers, Vocational education conceptual frameworks emphasize that effective teachers possess moral commitment and concern

(Advances in Vocational and Technical Education, 2022). These teachers understand that many students pursue technical programs in search of real-world opportunities for socioeconomic advancement. Technical-vocational instructors play a significant role in influencing students' career choices and life goals by providing mentorship and ongoing assistance.

In a contemporary educational milieu where practical competencies are attaining an equivalently critical status alongside theoretical knowledge, Technical Vocational (Tech-Voc) educators assume an increasingly pivotal function in equipping students for success in the real world. These pedagogues transcend the role of mere instructors; they serve as mentors who adeptly guide learners towards employment opportunities, entrepreneurial ventures, and sustained personal development within a competitive global economy.
