

Warm greetings.

In line with the recent deployment of MacBooks to teachers by the Bataan Government, we respectfully seek the support of the Bureau of Learning Delivery in facilitating the dissemination of the Bataan Teacher Survey to basic education teachers in the Schools Division of Bataan.

The survey was developed by *Dr. Damian Bebell*, an educational researcher from Boston College (USA) who has been studying educational technology implementation for over two decades (background information attached). The instrument aims to independently assess the technological capacity of teachers in the Division of Bataan, particularly in relation to their use of technology for teaching and learning. It also seeks to gather structured feedback on the professional development and training provided by Basecamp, an Apple Professional Learning Provider.

For optimal implementation, we respectfully recommend that participating teachers be given a pre-scheduled time and designated venue to complete the survey. The instrument may be accessed through a mobile phone, tablet, MacBook, or any internet-enabled device. Completion time is estimated at approximately 20 minutes per teacher.

We assure your office that all responses will remain anonymous and confidential. While limited background information is collected for analytical purposes, access to raw data will be restricted solely to the research team. Any findings that may be shared will be reported only at the cohort level and will not contain any personally identifiable information.

In this regard, we respectfully request the Bureau's assistance in endorsing and disseminating the survey link to school heads and teachers within the Division. Your leadership in encouraging participation will be instrumental in generating meaningful insights that may help inform future planning, device utilization strategies, and professional development initiatives.


