1. The Department of Education (DepEd) Regional Office III, in collaboration with Red Scope Communication Inc., shall conduct the Gatorade Fuel Tomorrow Academy (GFTA) Player of the Year 2025-2026 Awarding Program in selected schools across the region.

2. In this regard, this Office respectfully requests the submission of nominations subject to the following guidelines.

a. To be eligible for the award, the nominee must meet the following:

- i. Must be an active member of a school sports club or varsity program for at least 3 consecutive months within the current school year.
- ii. Must demonstrate good moral character, supported by a certification from the School Head or Guidance Counselor.
- iii. Must have no failing grade in any and must maintain a general average of at least 85% in the latest grading period.
- iv. Must be strictly enrolled in a public Junior or Senior High School (Grades 7-12) within the 500 participating Fuel Tomorrow Academy (T2) schools for S.Y 2025-2026.
- v. Must have participated in school, division, regional, or national-level athletic events within the current school year.
- vi. Must have contributed to their community or school through outreach, leadership, volunteerism, or related advocacy activities.

b. Nomination and selection process:

- i. **School level:** Only one learner per school may be nominated by the School Principal, Coach, or Sports Coordinator using the prescribed official nomination form. The duly accomplished nomination form, together with the required supporting documents, shall be submitted in a sealed envelope to the designated Division Office Representative on or before **February 20, 2026**.
- ii. **Division level:** The Division Office Representatives shall convene to deliberate on the entries submitted by the schools. Thereafter, the Division Office shall select the top three nominees. The three endorsed

- endorsed nominations shall be submitted to the Regional Office in a sealed envelope on or before **February 27, 2026**.
- iii. **Regional level:** The Regional Office Representatives shall convene to deliberate on the entries submitted by the Division Offices. Thereafter, the Regional Office shall officially endorse the top two nominees to the National GFTA Program Committee. The endorsed nominees shall be submitted to Red Scope Communication Inc. in a sealed envelope on or before **March 13, 2026**.
  - iv. **National Level:** The GFTA Program Committee shall evaluate and screen the Regional Finalists using an official scorecard aligned with the duly established criteria. The decision of the GFTA Program Committee and the Board of Judges shall be deemed final, executory, and non-appealable. No correspondence, inquiries, or requests for reconsideration regarding the final results shall be entertained.
3. Each nominee shall submit the following documents:
- a. Duly accomplished Nomination Form;
  - b. Updated School Form 9 (SF9) or Learner's Progress Report Card;
  - c. Official Nomination Letter duly signed by the Coach, Teacher, or School Head concerned;
  - d. At least one Peer Testimonial attesting to the nominee's character and sportsmanship;
  - e. Proof of GFTA Manual download (e.g., screenshot of the download confirmation from the nominating coach or school);
  - f. Certificate of Good Moral Character issued by the School Head or authorized school official; and
  - g. Other Means of Verification (MOVs) such as photos, attendance sheets, or a brief video introduction (optional).

- a. List of Selected Schools for the nomination of the GFTA Player of the Year.
  - b. Criteria for the GFTA Player of the Year.




