SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM (SBFP) – PROVISION OF VITAMIN C TABLETS FOR SBFP BENEFICIARIES FOR SY 2025-2026

1. In line with the implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) for School Year 2025–2026, this Office announces the distribution of vitamins to beneficiaries as part of the program’s end-of-school-year activities.
2. The Vitamin C tablets shall be administered to the learners once daily after meals for a duration of thirty-two (32) days. In cases of **partial delivery**, all received Vitamin C tablets shall be prioritized for distribution to current Grade 6 learners who are SBFP beneficiaries, followed by Kinder to Grade 5 learners in identified schools to ensure equitable and efficient utilization of available resources. An initial delivery to 10,544 out of 24,955 beneficiaries under the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) shall be provided with the said supplements.
2. The following is the allocation of vitamins per school per district for guidance and reference.
