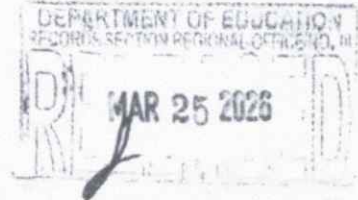

**ENHANCING ALS INSTRUCTIONAL PRACTICES: REGIONAL MASS TRAINING
ON THE REVISED K TO 10 CURRICULUM**

1. The Department of Education Region III Office, with the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) as lead, announces the conduct of the **Enhancing ALS Instructional Practices: Regional Mass Training on the Revised K to 10 Curriculum** on **May 13-15, 2026 (Batch 1)**, **May 19-21, 2026 (Batch 2)** and **May 27-29, 2026 (Batch 3)** in venues to be determined later.
2. The mass training of teachers is in line with Memorandum DM-LS-2025 - National Training of Trainers (NTOT) for the Revised ALS K to 10 Curriculum and OM-BAE-OD-2025-658 - Authority to Change the conduct of NTOT for the Revised ALS K to 10 Curriculum.
3. This 3-day training aims to enable ALS teachers to:
 - a. demonstrate understanding of the updated curriculum framework, revised learning competencies, and enhanced instructional and assessment strategies of the Revised ALS K to 10 Curriculum;
 - b. apply effective instructional planning, differentiated learning delivery, and assessment practices aligned with the Revised ALS Curriculum and the ALS Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) System;
 - c. ensure the standardized and effective delivery of the Revised ALS Curriculum, aligned with the formal school curriculum and responsive to the diverse learning needs of out-of-school youth, children in special cases, and adult learners (OSYCA); and
 - d. develop school- or Community Learning Center (CLC)-based action plans to support the consistent and sustainable implementation of the Revised ALS K to 10 Curriculum.
4. Participants shall include nationally trained ALS personnel, members of the Technical Working Group (TWG), ALS Division Supervisors/Focal Persons, Education Program Specialists II for ALS, and ALS teachers from the 21 Schools Division Offices (SDOs). All participants are required to bring their laptops, extension cords, and



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relevant reading materials and references.

5. In preparation for the actual conduct of the training, an online meeting of TWG and Resource Persons/Facilitators shall be held on May 4, 2026, @ 9:00 AM via MS Teams with this link: <https://tinyurl.com/2amxdxfh>.

6. Expenses for accommodation, meals, snacks, and other incidental costs related to the conduct of the training shall be charged to OSEC-3-25-02578 and ALS Program Support Funds (FY 2025 GAA NBC 595 FLO). Travel and other incidental expenses of division and school participants shall be charged to Division MOOE, Special Education Funds (SEF), and other local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
