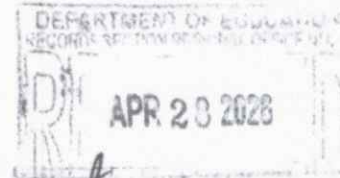

1. Pursuant to Memorandum DM-OULS-2026-148, dated April 26, 2026, titled **Online Orientation for School Heads on Learning Systems Strand Policies**, the Office of the Undersecretary for Learning Systems Strands announces the online orientation on **April 29, 2026**, from **9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.** via live streams. The link will be shared with the regional focal person.

2. The participants in the said activity are the School Heads from both Public and Private Schools. School heads should gather in groups at a designated location to watch the livestream and complete the orientation activities together. Schools Division Offices (SDOs) must submit the consolidated list of clustered viewing stations and their focal persons via email at clmd.ro3@deped.gov.ph on or before April 28, 2026.

3. Each SDO must assign a technical team to set up the following technical requirements for the clustered viewing:

- A screen and speakers for group viewing
- One device with a camera and a microphone for interaction with the session
- Internet access for all participants

4. Only one technical team device is allowed backstage for the livestream, and all assigned technical staff for clustered viewing stations must attend the tech run on April 28, 2026.

6. School heads are advised to bring an internet-enabled mobile device for interactive sessions and pens for completing activity sheets.

1. Following the agreements from the previous orientation sessions with the Regional Offices (ROs) and Schools Division Offices (SDOs), this memorandum is issued to provide guidance on the conduct of the **Online Orientation on Learning Systems Policies for School Heads in Regions II, III, and X** scheduled on April 29, 2026 from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM as detailed in the *Enclosure*.
2. The orientation will be conducted online via a **YouTube livestream**. The livestream link will be shared with regional focal persons on April 28, 2026.
3. ROs are directed to organize **clustered viewing sessions**. School heads should gather in groups at a designated location to watch the livestream and complete the orientation activities together. ROs must submit the consolidated list of clustered viewing stations and their focal persons via email at ouct@deped.gov.ph.
4. Each RO must assign a technical team to set up the technical requirements for the clustered viewing session. The technical team must ensure the following are available:
 - a. A screen and speakers for group viewing
 - b. One device with a camera and a microphone for interaction with the session
 - c. Internet access for all participants
5. Only one device from the technical team will be allowed backstage for the livestream.

6. All technical team members responsible for setting up a clustered viewing station are required to participate in a tech run on April 28.
7. ROs must provide participants with the orientation handouts during the event. The handouts are available for download here: <https://bit.ly/WorksheetsFromLS>
8. School heads attending the orientation are advised to bring the following:
 - a. **A mobile device with internet access**, for participation in the interactive sessions
 - b. **Pens** for filling out the activity sheets
9. ROs and SDOs shall oversee the conduct of clustered viewing activities and ensure the active participation of school heads during the workshop. Feedback from all participants shall be consolidated by the RO and forwarded to the Central Office upon completion of the event.
