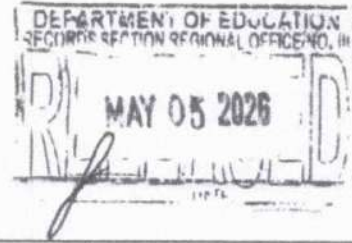

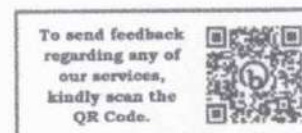

Rationale:

Pursuant to Republic Act (RA) 11476, also known as the "GMRC and Values Education Act," which institutionalizes Good Manners and Right Conduct (GMRC) and Values Education in the K to 12 Curriculum, mandates DepEd to carry out appropriate training for teachers and educators on GMRC and Values Education, as well as to provide them with adequate and relevant instructional materials to develop their capacity to teach the subject especially the non-major in Values Education.

In line with President Ferdinand Marcos, Jr.'s directive and the strategic plan led by Education Secretary Sonny Angara, this seminar aims to empower teachers in fostering an enabling learning environment, prioritizing their welfare, and promoting the well-being of learners. It emphasizes equipping educators with innovative strategies for efficient learning delivery and preparing a future-ready workforce by integrating 21st-century skills and values into the curriculum. By addressing these priorities, the seminar seeks to enhance the quality of education and support the holistic development of teachers and learners, aligning with the Department of Education's commitment to national progress.

The Quality Basic Education Development Plan (QBEDP) 2025-2035 advances the 5-Point Education Reform Agenda by focusing on teacher quality, safe learning environments, efficiency through data and digitalization, curriculum and assessment improvements, and preparing graduates for employment, entrepreneurship, or higher education. To meet these priorities, teachers, supervisors, and school heads must be empowered with values-based instructional management and leadership skills. Teachers, as frontliners in the classroom and future leaders of schools, play a vital role in ensuring learning success, while alignment with the Philippine Professional Standards for School Heads (PPSSH) strengthens strategic leadership, resource management, instructional focus, professional growth, and stakeholder engagement.

Regional Memorandum No. 013, s. 2024, titled "Implementation Guidelines on Strengthening Character Development through Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP)/Good Manners and Right Conduct (GMRC) and Values Education (VE)," reiterates the provision of continuous capacity building/training, retooling, and upskilling for EsP/GMRC-VE teachers following their years in service, or level of proficiency (RPMS, 2015) and needs. Regional Memorandum No. 661 s. 2023, titled Implementation Guidelines on the Adoption of the Ukit Marangal Framework in Support of the MATATAG Curriculum, that intensifies and instills a transformative culture among DepEd personnel, teachers, and learners.

The BEDP Basic Education 2030 envisions Filipino learners with physical, cognitive, socio-emotional, and moral preparation for civic participation and engagement in post-secondary opportunities. The core values emphasized in this framework include Maka-Diyos (God-fearing), Makatao (Humanitarian), Makakalikasan (Environmentally conscious), and Makabansa (Patriotic). Learners are encouraged to take pride in Filipino national identity, aspire for economic prosperity and socio-political stability, and live in a sustainable world. These values align with the institutionalized Good Manners and Right Conduct (GMRC) and Values Education as a core subject in the K to 12 curriculum, as mandated by Republic Act (RA) 11476.
