**DISPOSITION OF CONFISCATED AND
TURNED-OVER FOREST PRODUCTS**

This Office, through the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD), disseminates the attached invitation from the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) regarding the availability of confiscated and turned-over forest products consisting of logs that may be donated to qualified government agencies and instrumentalities for legitimate public purposes, subject to existing laws, rules, regulations, and DENR policies.

Schools within the municipalities of Dinalupihan, Hermosa, Orani, Samal, Abucay, Pilar, Orion, and Limay requiring wood materials for the construction, repair, rehabilitation, or improvement of school facilities and other government infrastructure projects may apply for the donation of available forest products.

Interested schools shall submit the required supporting documents to the concerned DENR Office. Attached is the letter from Ms. Marivic E. Santos, Community Environment and Natural Resources Officer, for information and guidance.

Pursuant to the mandate of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) in the disposition of confiscated and turned-over forest products, this Office respectfully informs your good Office of the availability of forest products consisting of turned-over logs which may be donated to qualified government agencies and instrumentalities for legitimate public purposes, subject to existing laws, rules, regulations, and established DENR policies.

In this regard, should any school within the municipalities of Dinalupihan, Hermosa, Orani, Samal, Abucay, Pilar, Orion and Limay, as well as the City of Balanga, under your jurisdiction requiring wood materials for the construction, repair, rehabilitation, or improvement of school buildings, classrooms, furniture, fixtures, and other government infrastructure projects, the concerned school may apply for the donation of available forest products for evaluation and appropriate action by this Office.

Further, pursuant to DENR Memorandum Order No. 162, Series of 1993, particularly Section 3 thereof, interested applicant-agencies are required to submit the following supporting documents:

1. Letter Request signed by the Head of Office or authorized representative;
2. Justification for the proposed construction project/ establishment of the infrastructure;
3. Bill of Materials and simple design/sketch plan; and
4. Certification issued by the Auditor, Treasurer, Budget Officer, or Development Officer that there is no fund of appropriation for the purchase of the required wood materials.

The processing, approval, and release of donated forest products shall be undertaken in accordance with applicable DENR rules and regulations governing the disposition of confiscated and turned-over forest products.
