**CONTINUATION OF THE CAMPUS YOUTH MINISTRY PROGRAM FOR  
SCHOOL YEAR 2026–2027**

In reference to the communication from the Diocesan Youth Ministry in Campus (DYMC), Roman Catholic Diocese of Balanga, signed by Rev. Fr. Julius Ma. M. Dayandante, MMHC, this Office informs all concerned of the continuation of the Campus Youth Ministry Program and its proposed activities for School Year 2026–2027.

The program aims to support the holistic development of learners through values formation, leadership development, youth engagement, and spiritual enrichment activities. Participation of learners shall be strictly voluntary and subject to existing DepEd policies, particularly those concerning the separation of church and state, the protection of learners, parental consent when necessary, and the conduct of activities within school premises. School Heads may coordinate with authorized representatives of the Diocesan Youth Ministry in Campus regarding the scheduling and implementation of activities.

Participation of learners from public schools shall be purely voluntary and shall not hamper instructional time, in compliance with the provisions of DepEd Order (DO) 009, s. 2026 titled "Guidelines on the implementation of the three-term school Calendar in Basic Education and DepEd Order (DO) No. 009, s. 2025, titled "Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith". Participation shall likewise be subject to policies ensuring learners' safety and well-being, the principle of the separation of church and state, and the no-collection policy stipulated under Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546, otherwise known as the Ganson Law, as implemented through DepEd Order No. 19, s. 2008, and reiterated in DepEd Memorandum No. 041, s. 2024.
