1. Pursuant to **DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2022** titled "*Omnibus Guidelines on the Regulation of Operations of Parent-Teacher Associations*", the schedule of Parent-Teacher Associations elections is outlined below.

2. Schools and Districts are advised to hold PTA elections through physical election (face-to-face), remote communication (online and offline), and hybrid communication (combination of physical and remote communication modalities) following the election procedures as provided in Article 4 Section 17.2 of DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2022.
3. Elementary and Secondary School Heads shall submit the List of School Parent-Teacher Association-BOD (SPTA BOD) and SPTA-EXECOM for School Year 2026-2027 and report on the conduct of the Homeroom PTA and School PTA-BOD election **on or before July 10, 2026**, through socmob.bataan@deped.gov.ph.
4. School Heads are advised to revisit DepEd Order no. 13, s. 2022.
5. Attached is the Regional Memorandum No. 184, s. 2026, for reference.
6. The Public Schools District Supervisors shall facilitate the Municipal Federated PTA. They shall provide the venue and logistic support, observe the election timeline, and shall not interfere with the conduct of the elections. **No District PTA Federation President** shall be elected for more than 1 district office.
7. The SDO – District Offices shall submit the list of Municipal Federated PTA-BOD Officers for School Year 2026-2027 **on or before August 10, 2026**, through this link: <https://tinyurl.com/2026MunicipalFPTA>.

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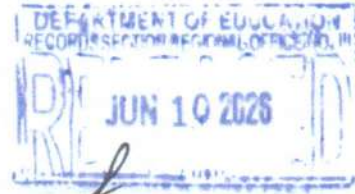

CONDUCT OF PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATION (PTA) ELECTIONS

To : Schools Division Superintendents
Chief, School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD)
Division PTA Coordinators
Public and Private School Heads
All Others Concerned



1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 13, series of 2022 titled "Omnibus Guidelines on the Regulation of Operations of Parent-Teacher Associations," the following shall be observed by all public, private, and non-DepEd managed schools offering the K to 12 Basic Education Program, to wit:

a. The conduct of PTA election of the new set of officers for Homeroom Parent Teacher Association (HPTA), Grade Level Parent Teacher Association (GrPTA), and School Parent Teacher Association- Board of Director (SPTA-BOD) shall be held **within 30 calendar days** from the first day of classes. In addition, school heads are requested to strategize in the conduct of the election to avoid class disruptions;

b. The municipal or city Federated Parent Teacher Association (FPTA) election of the Board of Director (BOD) members and its Executive Committee (EXECOM) Officers shall be **within 60 calendar days** from the first day of classes, while the election for the provincial FPTA-BOD members and its EXECOM Officers shall be **within 75 calendar days** from the first day of classes.

2. At the start of the School Year, the Election Committee (ELECOM) shall hereby be created and convened immediately with the following provisions.

- a. The ELECOM is composed of seven (7) members.
- i. School head as Chairperson; and
 - ii. Two teachers and four parent/guardian members as members to be
 - iii. appointed by the incumbent SPTA-BOD (or the outgoing SPTA-BOD. (see DepEd Order No. 13 s. 2022 for the criteria of selecting ELECOM members, page 10 of 74).

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- b. The Election Committee (ELECOM) shall have overall supervision over the conduct of the HPTA and GrPTA elections and direct supervision over the conduct of election of the teacher representatives to the BOD and SPTA-BOD Officers and shall serve until the end of School Year (SY).
3. In the Municipalities, the elections of the FPTA shall be facilitated by the Public Schools District Supervisor (PSDS) designated by the Schools Division Superintendent (SDS) while in cities and provinces shall be facilitated by the Schools Division Superintendent (SDS) with the following guidelines.
 - a. The SDS shall decide the composition and the manner of selection of the ELECOM members. The SDS may pattern after section 10.3 and other relevant sections of DepEd Order No. 13 s, 2022 the guidelines the duties and responsibilities to govern the ELECOM and the conduct of FPTA election; and
 - b. Shall provide the venue and logistical support, observe the election timeline, and shall not interfere with the conduct of the elections.
4. Further, the Regional Federated Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) Election will be on November 18, 2026. The venue shall be communicated in a separate Memorandum.
5. All Schools Division Offices (SDOs) through the Division PTA Coordinators are requested to submit the following on or before November 10, 2026 through this link: <https://tinyurl.com/PTA-Report-election>, to wit:
 - a. List of SPTA-BOD & FPTA-BOD officers and members for the current SY (together with their contact numbers and email addresses);
 - b. Copy of their latest by-laws certified by the SPTA/FPTA-BOD; and
 - c. Consolidated PTA Monitoring Form, attached as annex A of DepEd Order No. 13 s, 2022.
6. Travel and other expenses relative to the conduct of this activity shall be charged against the downloaded program support funds for partnership building and linkages subject to usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
