**CONTINUED IMPLEMENTATION OF THE OPLAN KALUSUGAN SA DEPED–
HEALTHY LEARNING INSTITUTIONS (OKD-HLI) PROGRAM FOR CY 2026**

1. Pursuant to the communication from the Department of Health (DOH) – Central Luzon Center for Health Development regarding the continued implementation of the **Oplan Kalusugan sa DepEd–Healthy Learning Institutions (OKD-HLI) Program** for Calendar Year 2026, this Office informs the field of the identified implementing schools within the Schools Division Office (SDO) of Bataan.
2. The OKD-HLI Program aims to strengthen health-promoting school environments and support the attainment of Healthy Learning Institution recognition through coordinated health, nutrition, sanitation, and wellness initiatives in schools.
3. Attached herewith is the list of implementing schools for CY 2026. (*See Annex A*) identified by the DOH-Central Luzon for Health Development.
4. School Heads of the identified schools are directed to:
 - a. organize and strengthen their School Health and Nutrition Teams;
 - b. implement the prescribed OKD-HLI standards and activities;
 - c. coordinate closely with District Supervisors, School Health Personnel, and Local Government Units to ensure program compliance;
 - d. maintain and update all required documentary evidences and accomplishment reports; and



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- e. participate in monitoring, validation, technical assistance, and assessment activities conducted by DepEd and DOH.
5. Public Schools District Supervisors shall provide technical assistance and monitor the implementation of the program within their respective districts.
6. The School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD), through the School Health and Nutrition Section, shall oversee the implementation, monitoring, and submission of required reports relative to this program.
7. Immediate and wide dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
