INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN LIYAB: THE MUSICAL CULTURAL MOBILIZATION

Participation of learners and teachers from public and private schools shall be purely voluntary and must not disrupt instructional time, in accordance with DepEd Order No. 009, s. 2026, titled "Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education"; and DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005, titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time- on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith. The activities are likewise subject to the No Collection Policy pursuant to Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546, otherwise known as An Act Prohibiting the Sale of Tickets and/or the Collection of Contributions for Whatever Project or Purpose from Students and Teachers of Public and Private Schools, as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 19, s. 2008, and reiterated in DepEd Memorandum No. 041, s. 2024. Furthermore, all activities shall be implemented with due consideration for the safety, protection, and well-being of all participants.

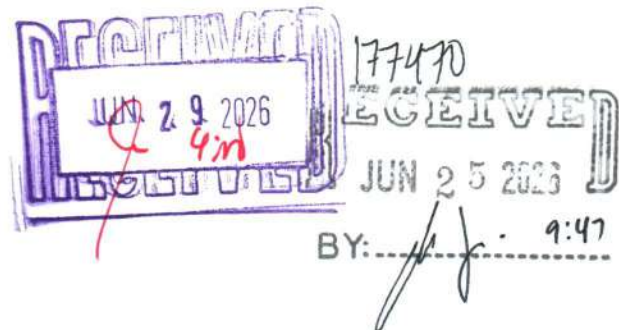

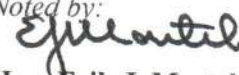
