Greetings of peace and prosperity!

The Bataan Organization of Public Secondary School Administrators (BOPSSA) respectfully requests permission to conduct a Training-Workshop on Philippine Folk Dances with the theme: "Sayaw at Kultura: Preserving Heritage, Mastering Steps of Philippine Folk Dances."

This activity aims to equip teachers with the practical mastery of the basic steps and movements of the most prominent traditional dances. It also seeks to strengthen cultural appreciation and support the effective integration of folk dance instruction in school programs.

The training-workshop is scheduled on October 17, 18, and 24, 2026, to be held at Vista Mall Bataan, Events Place. A registration fee of Two Thousand Pesos (Php 2,000.00) shall be collected from each participant to cover particularly the speakers' honorarium and meals as well as dance literature materials. However, meals of participants are not covered by said registration fee. Target participants are one (1) representative from small schools and one (1) pair from big schools for both elementary and secondary level. Moreover, private schools are highly encouraged to send their respective participants.

In this regard, we respectfully request your good office to issue a memorandum relative to this activity, indicating that the registration fee may be charged against the school's MOOE, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules. We further request that said memorandum serve as travel authority for the identified participants.

We sincerely hope for your support in this endeavor to promote and preserve our rich cultural heritage through education.
