In reference to the letter from the Philippine National Police (PNP), Bataan Provincial Police Office, signed by PCOL Marites A. Salvadora, Provincial Director, this Office disseminates that the PNP is accepting invitations from public and private schools within the Schools Division of Bataan to conduct an Awareness Campaign on "Nihilistic Violent Extremism (NVE)" for teachers, non-teaching personnel, and parents/guardians.

The awareness campaign aims to enhance participants' understanding of the nature, risks, and warning signs of Nihilistic Violent Extremism (NVE), including online grooming, radicalization, and exposure to violent ideologies. It likewise promotes responsible social media use, mental health awareness, and the importance of reporting suspicious activities to help safeguard learners from harmful influences.

The activity shall be facilitated by the Philippine National Police (PNP) Bataan Provincial Police Office in coordination with the Women and Children Protection Desk (WCPD) Officers of the Municipal and City Police Stations in Bataan.

Schools interested in conducting the Awareness Campaign on Nihilistic Violent Extremism (NVE) may submit their request to their respective Municipal Police Station or coordinate with Erlynn M. Fonseca, WCPD Investigator, through mobile number 0949-359-4072 or email at wcpd_bataan@yahoo.com.

Participation of learners and teachers from public and private schools shall be purely voluntary and must not disrupt instructional time, in accordance with DepEd Order No. 009, s. 2026, titled "Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education"; and DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005, titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time- on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith. The activities are likewise subject to the No Collection Policy. Furthermore, all activities shall be implemented with due consideration for the safety, protection, and well-being of all participants.
