CALENDAR OF SPORTS ACTIVITIES FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2026–2027

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 009, s. 2026, titled Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar and Activities for School Year 2026–2027, and in support of the Department of Education’s commitment to promoting physical fitness, sportsmanship, teamwork, and holistic learner development, this Office hereby provides the Calendar of Sports Activities for School Year 2026–2027.
2. The conduct of these activities aims to provide learners with opportunities to develop their athletic talents and values while identifying qualified student-athletes who may represent their respective schools, districts, and the Division in higher-level competitions.
3. The following calendar shall be observed by all public and private elementary, junior high schools, and senior high schools in the Division:

ACTIVITY	SCHEDULE
School Intramurals (after class hours/Weekends)	August-September 2026
District Meet/Unit Meet	September 2026
Provincial Meet	December 2026

4. All Districts shall submit to the Schools Division Office their consolidated Schedule of Sports Activities, including but not limited to School Intramurals, District meet, Unit Meet, trainings, meetings, practices, and other related sports activities, on or before **July 17, 2026**, for review and approval. The implementation of these activities shall be subject to existing DepEd policies and guidelines.

5. Consistent with DepEd Order No. 009, s. 2026 and other existing DepEd policies, all concerned shall ensure that the conduct of sports activities do not disrupt regular classes and instructional delivery.
6. School Heads, Sports Coordinators, coaches, trainers, and other concerned personnel shall schedule trainings, meetings, practices, and related activities in a manner that preserves instructional time and ensures the continuous delivery of classroom instruction. The suspension or interruption of classes solely for the conduct of sports activities shall be strictly avoided.
7. Schools are encouraged to maximize the use of designated activity periods, weekends, holidays, semestral breaks, and other non-class days, whenever practicable, in the conduct of sports-related activities and preparations.
8. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is hereby directed.
