1. This Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), will conduct A Literacy and Numeracy Assessment (LNA) Results Analysis and School Intervention Planning-Workshop on August 5-6, 2026 at The Mansion Hotel, Freeport Zone, Subic, Olongapo City. This is a live-in training and the opening program will start at 8:00 am.
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. equip school heads with skills to interpret LNA results and develop evidence-based interventions for literacy and numeracy improvement within their Schools; and
