Immediate and wide dissemination of this Advisory is desired.

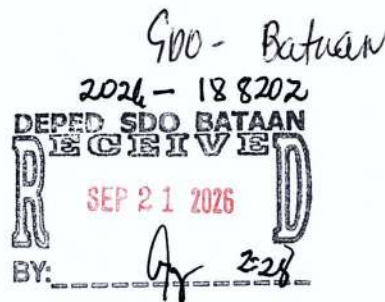

As we celebrate Girl Scout Week and the 73rd Council Anniversary of the Bataan Girl Scout Council, we honor a legacy of service, friendship, leadership, and empowerment that continues to inspire generations of Girl Scouts. This celebration is an opportunity for Bataan Girl Scouts to come together, discover their potential, strengthen their skills, and build meaningful connections with one another. In line with this momentous occasion, the Senior and Cadet Planning Board (SCPb), Junior Journalist Guild/Radio-Television (JGG/RTV), Service Auxiliary Volunteers for Emergency and Relief (SAVER), and the Girl Representatives of the Bataan Girl Scout Council have prepared engaging activities for Bataan Girl Scouts to celebrate the spirit and values of Girl Scouting. Through these activities, participants will have the opportunity to learn, serve, create, and celebrate 73 years of the Council's commitment to nurturing confident, capable, and compassionate Girl Scouts.

EVENT:	SCOUTING MONTH CELEBRATION 2026; 73rd Council Anniversary (Long Green Line)
PARTICIPANTS:	TWINKLER, STAR, JUNIOR, SENIOR, & CADET GIRL SCOUT
DATE:	Twinkler & Star Scouts Fun and Adventure Day (October 3, 2026, Saturday)
Venue:	Waltermart Bataan, Balanga City
VENUE	Junior, Senior & Cadet (October 31, 2026) Plaza de Mayor de Balanga (Assembly Area) Bataan People's Center (Event Proper)
THEME:	Rooted in Heritage: Rising to Lead

Troop Leader Ratio for Twinkler & Star and Junior Girl Scouts:

- a. A 2:8 adult-to-girl ratio will be strictly observed.
- b. For districts with 40 participants, only 10 troop leaders are allowed.
- c. For Upper and Lower Mariveles with a maximum of 200 participants each and a maximum of 30 troop leaders are allowed per district.



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FOR SENIOR AND CADET GIRL SCOUTS:

- Each participating school **may send a maximum of 32 participants** (combined total for Senior and Cadet levels).
- Troop Leader Ratio for Senior and Cadet Girl Scouts:
 - a. The 1:8 ratio will also be observed for these levels.
 - b. Schools with 32 participants may bring a maximum of 4 troop leaders.

DEADLINE OF REGISTRATION:

For Twinkler and Star Scouts: September 21, 2026

For Junior, Senior, and Cadet: October 9, 2026

Objectives:

- Bring the 8-Point Challenge to life through fun and interactive stations.
- Inspire Girl Scouts to discover new interests and abilities.
- Build strong bonds and teamwork among all participants.

QUALIFICATION OF PARTICIPANTS

1. Must be a registered Junior, Senior, or Cadet Girl Scout for the current girl scouting year.
2. Must be physically fit, alert, and mentally present.
3. Must have submitted necessary pre-event requirements and waivers.
4. The number of participants per district will follow council-declared quotas.

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PROGRAM OF ACTIVITIES (October 3, 2026)

Age Level: Twinkler and Star Scout

ACTIVITY TITLE	DESCRIPTION/MECHANICS
Stick-a-Thanks	A simple activity where Twinkler and Star Scouts can draw, write a short message, or decorate a sticky note to show appreciation, kindness, and to celebrate the dedication, guidance, and service of our beloved GSP Titas and Troop Leaders. 1. Each participant receives one or more council-stamped sticky notes. Each sticky note costs Php 1. 2. Draw, write a short message, or make a simple design on the sticky note. 3. Participants may write something kind, thankful, or encouraging. 4. Stick the finished note on the designated Appreciation Wall/Board. 5. Read and enjoy the colorful messages made by fellow Girl Scouts!
Snap the Confidence!	A fun photo activity where Twinkler and Star Scouts can express themselves and celebrate their uniqueness. 1. Choose a positive message such as "I Am Enough," "Be You," "I Am Unique," or "I Am Proud of Me." 2. Pose with the chosen message. 3. Take a photo at the booth. No need to print the photo. 4. Have fun, smile, and show your confidence! 5. After completing the activity, receive a blue yarn from the booth as a sign that you have finished.
Hand in Hand: Bonds That Last	A simple friendship activity where two Girl Scouts create a special hand-trace keepsake for each other. 1. Find a buddy to partner with. 2. Each Girl Scout traces their hand on a piece of bond paper. 3. Write your name inside the hand drawing. 4. Decorate your hand trace using crayons. 5. Carefully cut out the hand trace.



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	6. Give your hand trace to your buddy as a simple symbol of friendship and a bond that lasts.
Family Fun BINGO	A simple picture-based Bingo activity where Girl Scouts can think about fun things they have done with their families. 1. Get a Family Fun Bingo card from the council. 2. Look at the pictures in each Bingo box. 3. The facilitator will ask about the activities one at a time, such as "Have you done this activity with your family?" 4. If the answer is YES, check or mark the picture. 5. Continue until you complete a line or the designated challenge. 6. Have fun remembering the activities and moments you shared with your family!
I Trash You – But Only in the Right Bin!	A simple environmental activity that teaches Girl Scouts to keep the event area clean and practice proper waste segregation. 1. During the event, pick up any clean and safe trash that you see around the area. 2. Bring the collected trash to the booth. 3. Identify whether the trash is Biodegradable or Non-Biodegradable. 4. Put the trash in the correctly labeled bag/bin. 5. Help keep the event area clean while learning the importance of proper waste segregation.

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PROPOSED PROGRAM OF ACTIVITIES (October 31, 2026)

Age Level: Junior, Senior, and Cadet

ACTIVITY TITLE	DESCRIPTION/MECHANICS
Long Green Line	Assembly Area: Plaza Mayor de Balanga Assembly Time: 5:30 AM Destination: Bataan People's Center (BPC) The Long Green Line is a fun and meaningful Girl Scout activity that brings participants together through a simple walk that promotes unity, friendship, healthy movement, and care for the environment. 1. All participating Girl Scouts will assemble at Plaza Mayor de Balanga. 2. After the assembly and necessary reminders, the girls will walk together from the Plaza to the Bataan People's Center (BPC). 3. Participants are encouraged to stay with their group, follow the assigned route, and observe proper safety and discipline throughout the walk. 4. Upon arriving at BPC, the girls will participate in a fun and energizing Zumba activity. 5. After the Zumba session, the girls will proceed to the different booth activities prepared for the event, where they can participate in activities focused on friendship, appreciation, confidence, family, and environmental responsibility. Through the Long Green Line, participants are encouraged to enjoy the journey, build connections with fellow Girl Scouts, and demonstrate the spirit of Girl Scouting through unity, service, and active participation.



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	“No to Body Shaming.” “Confidence Has No Size.” 3. Strike a Pose! - Take a selfie or group photo while proudly showing your chosen message. 4. Celebrate Your Uniqueness - Participants are encouraged to appreciate their own appearance and recognize that every one is different and worthy of respect. 5. Challenge the Stereotype - Before leaving, participants may write one beauty stereotype or body-shaming statement they want to challenge, along with a positive statement that replaces it. 6. Share the Positivity - With permission, participants may have their photos displayed on the booth's “Body Confidence Wall” or shared through the event's official social media platform.
Tie Me Tight: Bonds That Last	1. Choose Your Beads - Select your favorite beads, colors, letters, and charms to personalize your friendship bracelet. 2. Pick Your Partner - Make a bracelet for yourself, a friend, or someone you would like to build a friendship with. 3. Create Your Bracelet - String the beads onto the bracelet cord and design your own unique pattern. 4. Add a Meaning - Choose beads or colors that represent something meaningful, such as friendship, kindness, courage, trust, or unity. 5. Tie the Bond - Securely tie your finished bracelet and exchange it with a friend or give it as a simple token of appreciation. 6. Make a New Connection - Participants are encouraged to introduce themselves to someone new and exchange friendship bracelets as a symbol of connection and inclusivity.
Family Fun BINGO	1. Get a Bingo Card - Each Girl Scout receives a Bingo card containing different family activities, experiences, and fun memories.



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ACTIVITY TITLE	DESCRIPTION/MECHANICS
Stick-a-Thanks	A simple appreciation activity where Girl Scouts can express their gratitude through heartfelt notes. Write a message, decorate it, and stick it on the Appreciation Wall to celebrate the dedication, guidance, and service of our beloved GSP Titas and Troop Leaders. 1. Participants receive one or more sticky notes from the booth. Each sticky note costs Php 1. 2. Write a short message of appreciation, gratitude, encouragement, or a favorite memory for a GSP Tita/Troop Leader. 3. Participants may address their note to a specific Tita or write a general message for all Troop Leaders. 4. Participants may add doodles, hearts, stars, or other simple designs to make your message extra special. 5. Place the complete sticky note on the Appreciation Wall/Board provided at the booth. 6. Participants may read the other messages and celebrate the dedication and service of our Titas.
Snap the Confidence!	A fun and empowering selfie booth that celebrates individuality, self-love, and body confidence. Strike a pose, choose an advocacy message, and show that confidence is not defined by appearance, size, shape, or color. This booth encourages everyone to embrace who they are and challenge harmful beauty and body stereotypes. Participants enter the selfie booth and choose a fun pose, expression, or gesture that represents their confidence and individuality. 2. Choose Your Message - Pick an advocacy statement or proposition such as: “I Am Enough.” “I love the way I am” “I was born this way.” “Every Body Deserves Respect.” “I am unique.” “Self-love is the key.” “Be You, Be Proud.”



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	2. Read the Squares - Girl Scouts go through each square and identify the family activities or experiences they have actually, shared with their family. 3. Mark Your Memories - Put a check mark, stamp, sticker, or color the square if the activity or memory is something the Girl Scout and her family have experienced together. 4. Remember & Reflect - As they mark each square, Girl Scouts are encouraged to recall the fun, meaningful, or memorable moments they shared with their family. 5. Complete the Challenge - Try to complete a horizontal, vertical, or diagonal line to make a Bingo. Girl Scouts may also challenge themselves to complete the entire card. 6. Share a Favorite Memory - After completing the Bingo challenge, each Girl Scout chooses one favorite family activity or memory from the card and shares it with the booth facilitator or writes it on the Family Memories Wall. 7. Celebrate Family Time! - Take a photo at the booth and celebrate the special moments, adventures, and traditions that make each family unique.
I Trash You – But Only in the Right Bin!	1. Bring Your Trash - Each Girl Scout may bring a piece of clean, safe household waste to the booth for proper disposal. 2. Know the 3 Bins - Identify the three labeled bins:  Recyclable,  Biodegradable,  non-biodegradable 4. Think Before You Throw! - Check the item and decide which bin it belongs in. 5. Trash It Right! - Deposit the waste into the appropriate labeled bin. 6. Get a Sweet Reward! - Girl Scouts who correctly segregate their waste receive a small candy as a reward. 7. Learn the 3Rs - Before leaving, participants are reminded to practice Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle in their homes, schools, and communities.
