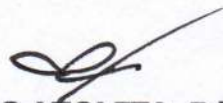

**15th REGION III PHILIPPINE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PRINCIPALS'
PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (PDP)**

1. The Philippine Elementary School Principals Association (PESPA) Region III Chapter, in partnership with the Department of Education Regional Office III, shall conduct the 15th Region III Philippine Elementary School Principals' Professional Development Program (PDP) with the theme: "Leading the Future: Innovative, Data-Driven, and Child-Centered School Leadership" on October 20-22, 2026, at the Supreme Hotel and Convention Center, Baguio City.

2. The Professional Development Program aims to:

2.1. Strengthen visionary and future-focused leadership among school heads to effectively respond to the evolving demands, innovations, and emerging challenges in basic education.

2.2. Enhance school leaders' competencies in utilizing Artificial Intelligence (AI) and other emerging technologies to improve school management, instructional leadership, governance, and organizational efficiency.

2.3. Promote data-driven decision-making by maximizing the use of educational data and analytics in planning, monitoring, evaluating, and improving school performance and learner outcomes.

2.4. Foster innovation and transformative leadership by equipping school heads with strategies for designing and implementing high-impact, evidence-based school improvement initiatives.

2.5. Strengthen child-centered leadership through effective school governance that ensures safe, inclusive, resilient, and future-ready learning environments where every learner can thrive.

3. The Professional Development Program shall feature plenary sessions focusing on the following major themes:

- a. Leading Beyond the Present: Empowering School Leaders to Shape the Future of Philippine Education (*Keynote Address*)
- b. Harnessing AI for Smarter School Leadership, Teaching, and Learning Using Data Analytics to Improve School Performance and Learner Outcomes
- c. Designing High-Impact School Innovations for Continuous School Improvement



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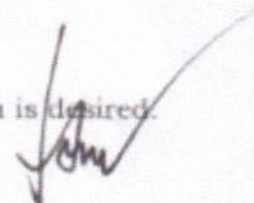




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d. Creating Safe, Inclusive, and Future-Ready Schools through Effective School Governance

4. The target participants are the Regional and Division PESPA Officers, School Principals, Assistant Principals, OIC-Assistant Principals, OIC-Head Teachers & TIC's including those interested Master Teachers and school heads of private schools.
5. Participation is **on official business** subject to the availability of funds.
6. Registration is strictly Online. All participants are required to complete their registration through the official online registration portal provided by the PESPA PDP 2026 organizing committee. To ensure smooth logistics and proper documentation, we will not accommodate walk-in or on the spot registrants during the event. Only those who have successfully registered online will be allowed to participate in the training sessions. Last day of registration will be on September 30, 2026.
7. A pre-registration fee of seven thousand eight hundred pesos (Php 7,800.00) shall be charged from each participant to defray expenses for hotel accommodation, meals, conference kits, venue, honoraria for speakers and other administrative costs charged against MOOE/ LSB Funds & local funds. Likewise, transportation & travel expenses can also be charged to MOOE/local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Registration fee shall be deposited on this RCBC account, Philippine Elementary School Principals Association Region III Incorporated with account number **7-589-64377-6**.
8. In consideration of travel time and post training reflections, October 19 (Day 0) and October 23 (day after the training) shall be accorded to participating school heads.
