Guidelines and Mechanics for Kwento ni Ma'am at Sir: A Celebration of Stories, Dedication, and Excellence"

Guidelines and Mechanics

1. This contest is open to all teachers in the Region, whether it comes from public or private schools.
2. Each School Division Office is requested to submit 1 entry of Kwento ni Ma'am at Sir: A Celebration of Stories, Dedication, and Excellence". The story must be original and based on the teacher's genuine experience.
3. The entry/story shall present one original and authentic story based on the experience of a teacher. The story may focus on the following:
 - The teacher made a meaningful impact on the learner/s;
 - A challenge in teaching that was successfully overcome;
 - A memorable teaching experience that provided an important life lesson;
 - An experience that demonstrated compassion and concern for a learner/s and a co-teacher/s;
 - A professional or personal achievement resulting from dedication to teaching, and;
 - An experience that best exemplifies the qualities of a Marangal at Mahusay na Guro.
4. The entry shall submit a storytelling video with a minimum time of 1.5 minutes and a maximum duration of 3.0 minutes. The video must clearly present the teacher's personal and professional story and demonstrate its connection to the theme, "Marangal at Mahusay na Guro" however, exceeding the maximum time limit, 1 point deduction for every 1 second in the final score.
5. Each School Division Office through their Division Partnership Focal Person is requested to submit the recorded video of their entry on Kwento ni Ma'am at Sir: A Celebration of Stories, Dedication, and Excellence" in a MP4 or MOV file recorded in 1080p resolution at 60 frames per second (fps), film horizontally in landscape mode on or before September 28, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. via this email address at ginnojhep.pacquing@deped.gov.ph.
6. The top 3 entries, in no particular order shall present during the Regional Celebration of World Teachers Day on October 1, 2026 in the City of San Fernando, Pampanga. After the presentation, their place/rank will be announced. The top 3 entries will be communicated through an advisory a day before the event.
7. The decision of the Board of Judges shall be final and irrevocable.

Criteria	Percentage
Relevance to the Theme Measures how clearly and effectively the story demonstrates the qualities of a <i>Marangal at Mahusay na Guro</i> .	25%
Content and Message Evaluates the depth, relevance, organization, authenticity, and overall lesson or message of the story.	30%
Creativity and Originality Assesses the uniqueness of the story and the creativity demonstrated in presenting it.	25%
Storytelling Delivery • Clarity and projection of voice • Confidence and stage presence • Facial expressions and gestures • Pacing and timing • Ability to engage the audience.	10%
Impact and Inspiration Measures the extent to which the story touches, inspires, motivates, or creates appreciation among the audience for the teaching profession.	10%

Guidelines and Mechanics for KaTeacher Duet Singing Competition

Guidelines and Mechanics

1. The KaTeacher Duet Singing competition is open to all currently employed DepEd teachers in the Region.
2. Each School Division Office is requested to submit 1 entry for KaTeacher Duet Singing competition which is composed of 2 teachers, the duo may be composed of any gender combination whether it comes from one school or from different public or private schools.
3. The KaTeacher Duet Singing competition shall sing a minimum of 3.0 minutes and a maximum of 5.0 minutes, however, exceeding the maximum performance time, 1 point deduction for every 1 second in the final score.
4. Each entry/duo shall choose their own competition music and appropriate for the event. The competition music must not contain lewd, inappropriate or offensive language.
5. The entry/duos may divide the song into solo parts, sing together, or use harmonization.
6. Simple choreography and appropriate props are allowed.
7. Costumes may be used but required.
8. Each School Division Office through their Division Partnership Focal Person is requested to submit the recorded video of their entry on KaTeacher Duet Singing competition in a MP4 or MOV file recorded in 1080p resolution at 60 frames per second (fps), film horizontally in landscape mode on or before September 28, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. through this email address at ginnojhep.pacquing@deped.gov.ph.
9. The top 3 entries/duos, in no particular order shall compete live during the Regional Celebration of World Teachers Day on October 1, 2026 in the City of San Fernando, Pampanga. The top 3 entries will be communicated through an advisory a day before the event.
10. The decision of the Board of Judges shall be final and irrevocable, Furthermore, judges shall not disclose individual scores or engage in discussions with competing entries during the live performance/competition.

Criteria for Judging

Criteria	Percentage
Vocal Quality & Singing Ability Quality of voice, vocal control, clarity, range, and singing technique.	35%
Harmony & Vocal Blending Ability of the two singers to complement each other, blend their voices, and maintain effective harmonization.	25%
Pitch, Timing & Rhythm Accuracy of notes, timing, rhythm, and synchronization with the accompaniment	20%
Song Interpretation & Musicality Emotional delivery, phrasing, dynamics, and ability to communicate the meaning of the song.	15%
Visual Presence, Audience Impact & Overall Performance Confidence, facial expressions, stage movement, interaction, and ability to engage the audience.	5%
Total	100%
